Summary

1. The Essex Countywide Travellers Unit (ECTU) will bring together Councils and other agencies across Essex to work together.

2. The main priorities of the Unit are education, health and social issues related to the traveller community. In addition matters related to fire and other health and safety issues are considered of high priority. Essex Police, Essex Fire Service and the National Health Service are signatories of the unit.

- 4. Appointment of Cllr Susan Barker as a member of the executive to the Essex Countywide Traveller Joint Committee.

Situation

- 8. The Essex Countywide Travellers Unit (ECTU) will undertake the following activities:
 - Fire safety on sites
 - Improving education outcomes
 - Health and social care
 - Management of local authority sites
 - Unauthorised encampments
- 9. The main priorities of the Unit are education, health and social issues related to the traveller community. In addition matters related to fire and other health and safety issues are considered of high priority. Essex Police, Essex Fire Service and the National Health Service are signatories of the unit.
- 10. An additional activity of the unit relates to unauthorised encampments on public land within the ownership of signatories of the unit. In essence the district's powers with regards to handling unauthorised encampments will be delegated to the unit. The unit will respond and take appropriate action where necessary on unauthorised encampments. The decision as to whether action is appropriate and levels of tolerance will considered by the unit, consistently through the County in line with the Code of Practice for Travellers to which this district is a signatory. The local authorities, through identified Single Points of Contact, will update the action of the unit to local members and neighbours.

11. The unit will not be involved on matters related to unauthorised development (i.e. development on private land). Such matters will remain within the remit of the Local Planning Authorities through their statutory planning powers. Although, the unit will assist with support, information in responding to unauthorised encampments and will assist with the serving of notices as necessary.
