Summary

The Council has until now had a Standards Committee appointed before the Local Government Act 2000 ("the Act") came into effect. This has been permissible under transitional arrangements contained in the Act. However these will cease to be available after the May 2007 elections and the Council needs to put arrangements in hand now to ensure compliance with the legislation then.

Recommendations

That the Council nominate a group of Members to appoint an independent person or persons to the Council's Standards Committee.

Situation

- The Act introduced a new ethical code of conduct for Members of local authorities. One aspect of the Act was that Councils were required to establish a Standards Committee. The Committee must comprise at least three people with at least one independent person. There is also a requirement that at least 25% of the Committee is comprised of independent persons. Finally where there are Parish or Town Councils within the district there must be at least one Parish or Town Councillor to sit on the Committee when it is considering Parish or Town Council matters.
- Standards Board guidance on best practice is that there should be at least two independent persons and at least two Parish or Town representatives. This Council complies with this guidance. In addition there are 4 elected Members, one from each of the political groups and the fourth selected by Full Council from nominations put forward by the groups.
- The appointment of the Committee followed the procedure laid down in the Act. However as it was appointed before the Act came into force it is necessary for the Committee to be reappointed at Annual Council following the May 2007 elections and in order to comply with the statutory formalities the positions of the independent persons must be advertised.
- The Constitution Task Group has considered and approved a job description/person specification/advertisement for the role and the advertisement will appear shortly. The present independent persons may or may not seek reappointment and it is possible that there may be other candidates. It is therefore necessary to establish a selection panel to interview candidates with a view to recommending appointments to Annual Council in May 2007. Members may consider that this function could be performed by the elected Members of the Standards Committee, the Constitution Task Group or another combination of Members.
