#### Situation

- The Local Government Act 2000 requires local authorities to have a Standards Committee. The Standards Committee (England)
  Regulations 2008 provide that a Standards Committee must have at least 25% independent persons and in respect of Councils which have parishes at least 2 representatives of Town and Parish Councils who are not also members of th principal council.
- This Council's Committee has 10 members, 4 elected Members of this authority, 3 independent members and 3 representatives of Town and Parish Councils.
- As was reported at Annual Council the resignation of Cllr Philip Leader as a Parish Councillor for Thaxted has created a vacancy for a Town and Parish representative on the Standards Committee. It has been the practice of this Council to request nominees for Town and Parish representatives from the Uttlesford Association of Local Councils. In response to a request for a nominee to fill the current vacancy the Association has requested that Cllr Mel Sullivan of Hatfield Heath Parish Council be appointed.
