Summary

1. At its meeting of 15 July 2014 Council resolved to appoint Mr Adrian Webb as s151 Officer on an interim basis. In the nine months since that decision Mr Webb and his team have overseen an unqualified audit, set out a medium term financial strategy and a budget for 2015-16, all to exemplary standard. This is on top of his other duties as a Corporate Director. It is considered that the appointment should be made permanent.
