The Committee received a schedule setting out the current position regarding outstanding Section 106 Agreements.

DCL49 DRAFT BUDGETS 2002/2003

Members received a report which outlined the Committee's initial draft revised estimates of direct costs and income for 2001/02 and estimates for next year 2002/03 prepared on the basis of existing approved levels of service. The draft figures were presented in the context of target Committee cash limits and policy priorities approved by the Council on 16 October 2001. Details were given of proposed savings which were part of a package intended to achieve these targets and reflect those priorities overall.

In answer to a question from Councillor Mrs Cheetham, the Committee was informed that about 25% of applications were for listed buildings (in association with a planning application) and about 10% were solely for listed building consent, which were fee exempt. The Committee was informed that fees were expected to be increased by the Government in the next financial year by at least 10%. Contingency money would be available for large applications that may go to appeal in the coming year. Councillor Clifford said that resources needed to be provided to maintain a first class service to the public.

RESOLVED that the Committee accept the administration's proposals for savings and the draft net direct costs budget and directs officers to prepare service plans and full budgets for 2002/2003 in the light of those decisions for consideration at the next cycle of Committee meetings.

Members were advised that the Ombudsman had concluded that he would not be pursuing the complaint and that the decision would be recorded as Ombudsman's discretion.
