Birchanger Parish Plan

Situation

- The community of Birchanger has produced a Parish Plan which describes the unique make up and character of the village; identifies its needs and desires for improvement and future development and; defines a plan of action to achieve the objectives identified.
- The plan was produced using the results of a Parish Survey (70% return), Issues Questionnaire (60% return) and Young Persons Questionnaire (44 replies).
- Within the Parish Plan there is a Village Design Statement, produced by the Parish Council, which lists a number of guidelines for redevelopments and alterations to existing buildings, for new construction and for commercial and industrial buildings. Importantly the guidelines are in conformity with adopted policy but provide a parish perspective to applying the policies.
- Adoption of the Parish Plan as a statutory Supplementary Planning Document (SPD), forming part of the Local Development Framework, is not included in the Council's Local Development Scheme. If appropriate, it would be possible to adopt the Plan in the future as a SPD to the Core Strategy and Development Control Policies Development Plan Documents. In the mean time it is considered appropriate for the Council to adopt the Parish Plan as non-statutory planning supplementary guidance.
