No objection is raised to the felling of the Acacia tree at No. 47, Recreation Ground, Stansted.



1 The Acacia tree has been inspected by the Council's Landscape Officer and found to be a relatively young specimen of some 8 metres in height and in poor general health with significant branch tip die back present in the crown. The tree is situated in the rear garden of the property and is visible in limited views from Mill Side. The tree is not considered to be of an amenity value worthy of being given protection under a tree preservation order.
