PROPOSAL FOR BOUNDARY CHANGE: TAKELEY AND LITTLE CANFIELD

Proposal

Residents were asked for their views on the Council's preferred option that there should presently be no change to the existing boundary.

A total of 68 forms were returned with 61 agreeing to the proposal and 7 disagreeing.

Residents were also asked to indicate their choice from a list of further options by marking from '1' as most favoured and '6' as least favoured. Of the 61 who had agreed to the above proposal and that completed the options the results were as follows:
