**Community Governance Review Consultation on Parish Boundary Change:
Foresthall Park**

You will recall that I wrote to you in August as part of this consultation, to seek your view on the need for any changes to the parish boundary between Birchanger and Stansted. The reason for undertaking a review is to take account of the increasing level of occupation at Foresthall Park, so as to reflect the community identity of those living there. The consultation includes all residents living in and around the estate of Foresthall Park, and also the two parish councils of Stansted and Birchanger.

All proposals received at the first stage have now been considered by the Council's Electoral Arrangements Working Group. The enclosed voting form sets out the proposal which was identified to go forward for consultation. Briefly, that proposal is:

- **Transfer to Stansted Mountfitchet the whole of the residential development area known as Foresthall Park**

A map showing how the proposal would alter the parish boundary is available for inspection at the Council Offices during normal working hours. The map and other information about the proposal may also be viewed on the Uttlesford District Council website at www.uttlesford.gov.uk.

The voting form provides you with the opportunity to state whether you agree with this proposal. I would therefore request that you take part in the consultation by completing and returning the form to the address above. It is very important that a good response to the consultation is obtained to test the support for this proposal and I would urge you to take part. Please note responses should be returned before the consultation closing date of **1 February 2011**.

I look forward to receiving your views about the future direction of your community to help the Council decide what changes should be made.
