- 3. Consultation on the Issues and Options for the Core Strategy took place over the summer. In the current LDS, consultation on preferred options should be taking place in October/November. However, responses to the Issues and Options have raised issues about the possible soundness of the plan. Officers consider that the most appropriate way to address this would be to hold a further, more detailed issues and options consultation in Jan/Feb 2007 and proceed to consultation on preferred options in August/September 2007. This will also allow any implications arising from the publication of changes to the RSS to be fully taken into account. The Core Strategy would then be submitted in February 2008 and adopted in April 2009. These revisions will have knock on effects on the timetables for the Site Specific and Development Control DPD's. Consultation on Issues and Options for these will not start until the Core Strategy policies have been submitted to the Sec of State and they would not be adopted until July 2010.
- 4. The revised LDS can be viewed on the website under Planning/Local Plans and Local Development Framework/The Local Development Scheme. New text is shown highlighted. Deleted text is shown with a strikethrough.
- 5. The revised LDS will be sent to the Secretary of State who then has 28 days to consider it. It will also be sent to the Planning Inspectorate for information. If no direction is received from the Secretary of State, then the revised Local Development Scheme can come into effect after that time following resolution by Council.
