# **Vehicle Replacement Programme**

1. The current vehicle replacement policy is to replace light goods vehicles, such as transit vans and small mechanical sweepers, every 5 years and to replace heavy goods vehicles, such as refuse freighters and septic tanks every 7 years. It is envisaged that this policy will be reviewed as part of the 2009/2010 capital programme appraisal process to ensure the Council maximises its return on these vehicles.
