Reason(s) for Amendment(s) Sought: There is nothing on air quality as a planning objective as under Housing "access" is not mentioned. This is particularly important in Saffron Walden.

Comments:

Annual mean value data on air quality indicates that this is not a particularly significant issue in Saffron Walden, although localised poor air quality may occur under particular weather conditions with local short term traffic congestion.
