#### **Situation**

- 3. The council is in the process of establishing an Officer Capital Working Group to review and approve bids for submission to Committee for inclusion in the 2010/11 capital programme. The recommendations from this group will feed into that process.
- 4. The recommended ICT programme for 2010/11 consists of three new projects:
  - a. An upgrade from Microsoft Office 2003 to Office 2007 (£80,000)
  - b. A replacement Revenues and Benefits system in conjunction with the Strategic Solutions agenda (£300,000)
  - c. The establishment of a working environment and disaster recovery centre at Walden Place (£30,000 HRA)
- 5. There is also one 2009/10 project which has been delayed to 2010/11 due to the requirement to undertake the replacement backup solution:
  - a. A new network (including VOIP) at the Saffron Walden Offices (£140,000). Some consultancy and initial exploratory work will be undertaken in 2009/10.
- 6. There are also two 2010/11 projects which were approved in 2009/10 which remain in the programme:
  - a. Minor Projects (a general budget for 2 small projects to be identified) (£20,000)
  - b. Corporate Workflow (part of the EDRM project ) (£70,000)
- 7. If approved, this gives a very challenging capital programme for 2010/11 consisting of:
  - a. Microsoft Office 2007 upgrade
  - b. A replacement Revenues and Benefits system
  - c. Creation of an office environment at Walden Place
  - d. A new network at the Saffron Walden Offices
  - e. Minor Projects a general budget for 2 small projects to be identified
  - f. Corporate Workflow
