### Summary

Attached for information is the current IT Strategy (entitled 'E-Government Strategy: 2004 to 2007'). This document has been the driving force behind the direction taken by the IT Section for the previous two and a half years.

Whilst it is acknowledged that the document needs revision, there are currently two outstanding issues that need to be resolved before such a revision can take place. These are:

1. The future direction of the ICM (Integrated Customer Management) project; and
2. The requirements for eGovernment beyond 31 March 2006.

Item 1 will be resolved by the middle of February 2006 and item 2 by the end of March 2006. Once these two issues are resolved a new strategy can be prepared.
