#### **Annexe 1 - Mandatory Conditions**

Mandatory conditions - supply of alcohol

- 1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence
  - at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence or
- at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended
- 2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- 3 (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
  - (2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

#### Annexe 2 - Conditions Consistent with Operating Schedule

- A CCTV system to be installed and maintained (or any existing system maintained) and to be fully operational throughout the hours that the premises are open for any licensable activity.
- The CCTV system shall be capable of producing immediate copies of recordings on site. Copies of recordings will be capable of being recorded digitally on to CD/DVD or other equivalent medium.
- Any recording shall be retained and stored in a suitable and secure manner for a minimum of 28 days and shall be made available to the police for inspection on request.
- The CCTV system to incorporate a camera covering the entrance door and the alcohol display areas and will be capable of providing an image which is regarded as identification standard. The precise positions of the cameras may be agreed with the police from time to time.
- 5 The system will display, on any recording, the correct time and date of the recording.
- A system to be in place to maintain the quality of the recorded image.
- The premises licence holder will at all times maintain adequate levels of staff. Such staff levels will be disclosed, on request, to the licensing authority and police.
- Adequate waste receptacles, for use by customers, shall be provided in and immediately outside the premises.
