POLICE OBJECTION NOTICE

Dear Ms Turner

It is my duty to inform you that Essex Police are objecting to the application to vary the premises licence of Indian Villa Restaurant, 20 Watling St, Thaxted, Essex CM6 2PE to change of DPS to the above named person. The objection is made to the Uttlesford District Council Licensing Committee. This notice is served under the Licensing Act 2003 Section 37 (5) that Essex Police consider that there are exceptional circumstances in this case and that the granting of this application would undermine the crime prevention objective whereby the applicant is the current manager of this premises which was subject to an Immigration enforcement operation on 14/06/2017.

During the enforcement visit two Bangladesh nations who were working illegally at Indian Villa were encountered who had no right to work in the UK. One was removed from the premises and one arrested and taken to detention.

It is the contention of Essex Police that as the full time manager and the holder of a personal licence Mohammed HUSSAIN would have been aware that these persons had no right to work yet he allowed them to do so. No right to work checks were undertaken by the manager Hussain, the current DPS Dilera Malique or the Premises Licence Holder Muhammed Malique. This demonstrates a lack of management control and due diligence by those persons who were responsible for supervising the premises. It should be noted that Essex Police are seeking REVOCATION of the premises licence under separate application.

Anraele 1 - Mandatory Conditions

Mar datory conditions - supply of alcohol

- 1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence
 - at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence or
- at a time when the designated premises supervigor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is sus Pended



- 3 (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
 - (2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.
- A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which 4 is less than the permitted price.
- 5 For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 4 -
 - (a) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979(a);
 - (b) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula -

$$P = D + (D X V)$$

where -

- P is the permitted price.
- (ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
- (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
- (c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence -
 - (i) (ii) the holder of the premises licence.
 - the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
 - (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;
- (d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
- (e) "value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994(a).
- 6 Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 5 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
- -(1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 5 on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.
 - (2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

Embedded Conditions of 1964 Act

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No person under fourteen shall be in the bar of the licensed premises during the permitted hours unless one of the following

(1) He is the child of the holder of the premises licence.

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ANNEXES continued ...

(2) Heresides in the premises, but is not employed there.

(3) He is in the bar solely for the purpose of passing to or from some part of the premises which is not a bar and to or from which there is no other convenient means of access or egress.

(4) The bar is in railway refreshment rooms or other premises constructed, fitted and intended to be used bona fide for any purpose to which the holding of the licence is ancillary.

In this condition "bar" includes any place exclusively or mainly used for the consumption of intoxicating liquor. But an area is not a bar when it is usual for it to be, and it is, set apart for the service of table meals and alcohol is only sold or supplied to persons as an ancillary to their table meals.
