We note in the introduction of the screening report that reference is made to the Conservation of Habitats and Species regulations 2010, we would point out that an amendment to the regulations came into force in August 2012.

We are generally satisfied that the screening report fully covers our concerns and consider that the screening assessment has been carried out in line with appropriate legislation and guidance. We can therefore confirm that we agree with the Report's conclusions that the Core Strategy would not be likely to have a significant effect on a European Site either alone or in combination with other plans or projects, and no further assessment work is required at this stage.
