The horse chestnut tree is a mature specimen situated in the front garden area of 12, Saville Close (Appendix 1). The tree has been subject to a previous crown reduction (Appendix 2). The proposed pruning back to the previous pruning points is considered to be appropriate management to maintain the health and integrity of the tree.
