- 6. Notification of intent to fell five trees in the grounds of the Saffron Walden Castle has been made by the UDC Surveyor (Estates). The trees are within the Saffron Walden conservation area (Appendix 1: location plan). The reason for seeking the felling of these trees is to improve views of the castle as part of the restoration and public access improvement works currently being carried out to this registered Ancient Monument.
- 7. The trees proposed to be felled are 1no. pine, 1no. horse chestnut, and 3no. hornbeam (Appendix 2, 3, & 4). These trees are mature specimens of some amenity value in their own right. However, there are not considered to beneficially contribute to the special qualities of the setting of the castle; and they diminish the prominence of the ruins in views taken from Castle Street, Castle Hill, and from vantage points on The Common. None of the trees proposed to be felled are of historical or other special importance.
