Situation

5. Prior to 2007 the Code of Conduct provided that members must not disclose information given to them in confidence by anyone or information acquired which the members believed to be of a confidential nature without the consent of the person authorised to give it or unless required by law to do so. The 2007 Code of Conduct introduced two additional circumstances where disclosure of confidential information is permitted. The first of these is where the disclosure is made to a third party for the purpose of obtaining professional advice providing that the third party agrees not to disclose the information to any other person or where the disclosure is reasonable and in the public interest and made in good faith in compliance with the reasonable requirements of the authority.
6. I will give members a brief Powerpoint presentation on the issue of confidentiality and thereafter will seek members' views in accordance with the recommendations to this report.
