Background

- The Council granted outline planning permission for the expansion of Stansted Airport from 15-25mppa on 16 May 2003. The outline planning permission is subject to conditions and is also subject to a Section 106 Agreement, which places various obligations upon the airport operator that are triggered at times between the grant of the permission and by the end of 2010.
- No start has yet been made on the development and no planning conditions have yet been triggered. A formal start to works was to have been made in mid 2005, when the terminal forecourt access road area was to have been remodelled. These works have been postponed pending a survey of the structural implications of the remodelling works upon the railway station roof. This survey is currently being undertaken.
