Supplementary note for Extraordinary Council Meeting

Officer's Report

Para 4 of the note on SSE's comments states:

This was included in the report to the Planning Committee on 14 November. The number of air transport movements now forecast at 35 mppa is not to be treated as a limit. The Secretary of State acknowledged in his 2008 decision that 264,000 ATMs were acceptable. STAL's current proposals do not seek to relax that limit.

The last sentence should have read:

The Secretary of State acknowledged in his 2008 decision that 274,000 total movements were acceptable. STAL's current proposals do not seek to relax that limit.

Para 7 stated:

The World Health Organisation Environmental Noise Guidelines published on 22 October 2018 were a matter put to the Planning Committee in SSE's presentation to members and in the officer's report. No weight can be attached to these guidelines as they are directed at Governments in preparing national policy on airports and aviation and not to local authorities.

The last sentence should have read:

Negligible weight can be attached to these guidelines as they are directed at Member States in preparing national policy on airports and aviation and not to local authorities.
