#### **Summary**

1. The Car Park Review and Consultation report on tonight's agenda, item 14, was presented to the Scrutiny Committee on the 13 February. This report is a supplementary paper to the main report.

- 2. At the meeting of Scrutiny, the Portfolio Holder for Finance and the Economy announced that following the Cabinets review of the consultation responses and the petition submitted by the Saffron Walden BID, it has been agreed to amend the original proposals.
- 3. The proposals to be amended:
  - i. To retain the 30 minute tariff option in the Saffron Walden Car Parks
  - ii. To reduce the increase in the cost of season tickets
  - iii. To retain the long stay option at the Crafton Green Car Park in Stansted Mountfitchet
  - iv. The hybrid season tickets will be aligned with the new monthly season ticket prices

  - a. approve the parking tariffs and changes to the management of the car parks as set out in paragraph 10, and as amended in paragraph 11
  - b. decide on the season ticket option for Stansted as set out in paragraph 18, table 4 or as amended in table 4.1

#### **Background Information**

- 7. This paper is a supplementary paper to the main agenda item for the Car Park Review and Consultation Responses also on tonight's agenda.
- 8. This paper supports the discussions held at the Scrutiny Committee on the 13 February and the agreed outcomes announced by Cllr Hargreaves on behalf of the Cabinet on the Car Park review proposals.
- 9. The original proposals are listed below for reference, and these are set out in more detail in the main report on tonight's agenda.
- 10. Members at their Cabinet meeting on the 20 December 2023 agreed to consult on the following proposals.
  - I. Car Park tariff increases as per option 2
  - II. Extending the daily parking chargeable period to 6pm (currently 5pm)
  - III. To remove the 30 minute tariff from all Saffron Walden only car parks. This would make the minimum parking charge time one hour.
  - IV. A flat rate charge for Sundays and Bank Holidays is introduced, at a fixed daily cost of £1.50 in Saffron Walden and £1.00 for Great Dunmow and Stansted.
  - V. Catons Lane car park to become a chargeable car park, it is further proposed that the charges are aligned with Swan Meadow as both will function as long stay car parks.
  - VI. London Road (Council Offices car park) to become a chargeable car park at weekends and charges for Saturday will be aligned with Swan Meadow as it will operate as a long stay car park.
    - It is proposed that a resident parking permit is introduced to align with the permit scheme offered to residents in Swan Meadow.
  - VII. To remove the long stay parking option and season tickets in Crafton Green, making the maximum stay three hours.
  - VIII. To remove the season ticket option in Chequers Lane, this has always been a short stay car park and season tickets are normally only provided in long stay car parks.

- IX. To introduce a hybrid season ticket to accommodate the change in people's working patterns. This would offer discounted parking in the same way a standard season ticket does, but with a variation to the number of days it is usable in a fixed period of time.
- X. The MiPermit convenience fee is included in the fee charged when parking using the mobile app.
- 11. The changes to the original proposals are
  - a. To retain the 30 minute tariff options in The Common, The Rose and Crown and Fairycroft car parks in Saffron Walden shown in paragraph 14, table 1.
    - The charge for this is proposed to be 80p matching the cost for the same period in both the Great Dunmow and Stansted Mountfitchet car parks
  - b. To reduce the season ticket prices as set out in the table in paragraph 14, table 4.
  - c. To align the new monthly hybrid season tickets costs with the standard monthly season ticket costs set out in paragraph 15, table 5.
  - d. To retain the long stay option in Crafton Green car park in Stansted Mountfitchet, at a proposed cost of £4.50. To include retaining season tickets for the locally employed at a proposed cost aligning with Great Dunmow and Saffron Walden.
- 12. The costs of the season tickets have been aligned across the district, so a locally employed worker pays the same whichever town they work in.
- 13. Season tickets in Stansted cost less than in Saffron Walden and Great Dunmow making the amended increase a bigger % increase for Stansted users. The cost of a 6 month season ticket is proposed to be £260 and £450 for a full year, this equates to a 100% increase for 6 months and 80% increase for a full year in Stansted. These proposed increases for Great Dunmow and Saffron Walden only equate to a 50% increase for all options.
- 14. Crafton Green is owned by Stansted Parish Council and the Council manages the car park on their behalf and as such the charges are subject to consultation with the Parish Council. A meeting was held with the Parish clerk on Friday 16 February to discuss the updated proposed cost of season tickets.
- 15. Stansted councillors are not aware of the revised costs at the time of writing this report. The proposals in paragraph 18 table 4 show the costs of aligning all towns, but Stansted councillors might request that this is reviewed, and the costs are increased by the same % as the other two towns, making the cost of a 6 month season ticket £195 and a full year £375, as set out in paragraph 18 table 4.1.
- 16. Where Members have agreed to retain the 30 minute tariff in Saffron Walden, the long stay option and the season tickets in Crafton Green, the proposed charges for these will be subject to a 21 day notice of variation.
- 17. The notice of variation will be displayed following the approval of the options and amendments at tonight's meeting.
- 18. The following tables set out the original tariff options which were consulted on, and the amendments made to these proposals following the consultation. The amendments are highlighted in yellow.
