The Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (England) Regulations 2020	Leader of the Council; Lead for Strategy, the Economy and Investment	13 May	Fixed Penalty Notices are an enforcement sanction often used as a sanction or as an alternative to more formal legal proceedings. The Council already issues fixed penalties for a variety of offences and over time new fixed penalties and charges are introduced that can assist officers in their day to day duties. The most recent introduction originates from The Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (England) Regulations 2020. The Regulations provide the power for an 'authorised person' to issue a fixed penalty notice to anyone over the age of 18 who they reasonably believe has committed an offence under the Regulations.
