Notice is hereby given under the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 ("the Regulations") Regulation 10 (general exception), that the following key decision(s) will be made by Cabinet on 18 April 2024

#### Procurement of Housing Repairs, Maintenance and Capital Improvements provision from 2025

The Chair of the Scrutiny Committee has been informed in writing of the matter about which the decision is to be made.

Reason why notice of the decision could not be published at least 28 clear days before the key decision is to be made and therefore requires general exception measures: The Council has a statutory obligation under the Social Housing Act to consult with tenants when making a change to service provision. The proposals which will be determined by Cabinet on 18<sup>th</sup> April were considered by members of the Tenants and Leaseholder Panel on 4<sup>th</sup> April 2024 in order to make a recommendation to Cabinet.

Key decisions are decisions which:

- Are likely to result in the Council incurring expenditure or making savings in excess of £100,000 subject to the following:
  - o Decisions on the acquisition or disposal of land or of an interest in land will be key decisions if their value exceeds £500,0001.
- Are likely to be significant in terms of its effects on communities living or working in Uttlesford.

Loans or borrowing decisions made in accordance with the Treasury Management Policy.

Decisions relating to the engagement of staff unless falling within paragraph 4.

Contract awards or renewals for vehicles, plant, machinery, goods, supplies and services where budget provision has been made and the award or renewal is within budget.

o Contract awards where the decision to let the contract has already been treated as a key decision.

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- Relate to the adoption or revision of plans and policies which would have a significant impact on the way in which the Council carries out its statutory functions.
- Relates to consideration by the Cabinet of proposals which would have a significant impact on the provision of services to the public or on the operational management of the Council.

Decisions to be taken in private are also listed (this is where specific exemptions apply under Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972).
