Reasons:

In order to take account of the changes in legislation brought about by the introduction of the Homelessness Reduction Act 2017, which came into force on 3 April 2018; and to update the wording of the Allocations Policy to substitute for the wording "honourable discharge" (which is no longer used) with the wording "applicants who are serving members of the Regular Forces or who have served in the Regular Forces".
