<u>Saffron Walden Museum's new exhibition Evacuee: A Wartime Childhood has opened and runs until March.</u>

It features the original artwork of artist and author Brian Sanders, whose decadeslong career includes working on books, magazines, stamp and coin designs and editorial and advertising. He's worked on the American TV show Mad Men and he's worked with Stanley Kubrick.

However, of particularly local interest are his two beautifully illustrated books Evacuee: A Wartime Childhood and Return of Evacuee: A Post-war Childhood which chronicle his own experiences of coming to Saffron Walden as an evacuee.
