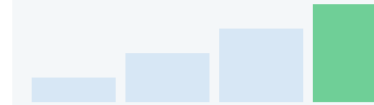

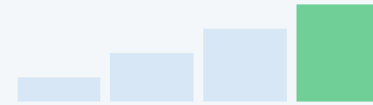

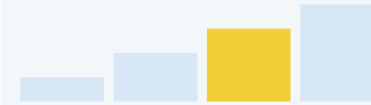

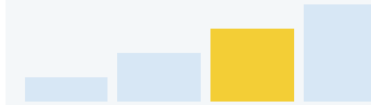

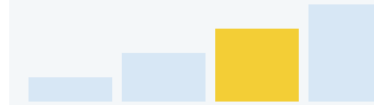

# 23-24 Operational Challenges

- New rounds in spring
- Changes in tipping locations
  - Domestic waste Dunmow moved to Braintree 45 min extra per trip
  - Garden waste Ongar and Haverhill to Birch (Tiptree) 1 hour 15 per trip
- District Growth
- Staffing issues
- Vehicle breakdowns and availability



# Measures to Address Issues

- Reviewing current service capacity
  - District growth has been previously absorbed
- Capital programme reprofiling to replace our spares
  - 1 new lorry for above
  - 2 spares replaced
- Exploring an alternative tipping location for garden waste
- Continuing to tweak collection rounds
