

Council Spending – have your say A survey to Uttlesford businesses

A summary report on the survey of businesses about council spending priorities for the year 2019-20

For 2018, a link to the online survey was sent to the 833 businesses registered on the Uttlesford Business Directory. The 26 returns, although a minor increase on the 2017 response (21 returns), represent a relatively low level of response compared with 80 submissions in 2016.

The consultation was run over the period 18 July to 6 August 2018.

Results priorities

Consultees were asked: "For each service, please indicate whether you consider it to be a high priority, a medium priority or a low priority."

Headline	Spending Area – ranked top three priorities
Ranked priority	Planning how the district will develop in the coming decades, including where new housing and businesses will be located (94.67%)
	2. Emptying bins and running the recycling service - (92.75%)
	3. Deciding planning applications and making sure new buildings and extensions are built according to approved plans and following building regulation (89.86%)

Headline	Spending Area – ranked by the least respondents		
Ranked priority	Continuing to explore external commercial opportunities,		
	such as the 50% purchase of Chesterford Research		
	Park, to bring in extra income for the council - (56.52%)
